

Marital union of thought: Why did I get Married?

Jacob is the main character – Genesis 25:24-28

Esau dwelt in the field...laboring from the sweat of his brow to take care of himself.
Jacob dwelt in the tents...in the tent he had time for contemplation and meditation.

With the assistance of his mother he secured the blessing of his FATHER.

Isaac could smell, touch, taste and hear but he could not see. His felt betrayed and deceived because his inner eye saw what he sensed.

We all must learn to see inwardly what we sense outwardly and sense inwardly what we see outwardly to follow the blessing plan of the FATHER.

Once Jacob secured the blessing on top of the birthright from his FATHER, he went out to get married. Every man must have a God- given vision for his life before finding a wife. Proverbs 18:22

Laban offered two daughters but Jacob was set on Rachel. She was his desire. To kiss her was out of order. His response (cried) was because his desire had pulled him out of character. He had to compose himself.

“A double minded man is unstable in all of his ways. Let that man not think he will receive anything of the Lord.”

Prayer is the word and the spirit at work in the believer.

Every desire is a prayer. You cannot pray until the thing desired becomes a mental picture. Do not picture anything you don't want expressed in your life.

Laban represents the world system of labor for reward. Father calls us to work but not to labor. There was no consideration for Jacob's household. A man that labors for another must also consider his own household.

READ: Genesis 30:26-30

Marriage is designed to bring two into union for the purpose of creation (imagination is creation), recreation (enjoy the fellowship and relationship) and reproduction (reproduce after your own kind).

The first visible act of this marital union is in Genesis as the coupling of “the WORD and The SPIRIT” created ALL things. Genesis 1:1-26

We are comprised of Spirit – soul and body. In the original Hebraic writings, the Spirit is always in the masculine gender, the soul in the female gender and the body is merely the outward manifestation of the inner working of the soul and the spirit.

James 1 tells us that as our soul is reborn by the engrafted WORD of GOD, it allows the Spirit to produce new results in our lives.

Rachel could NOT bring forth children in the NATURAL. Divine intervention was needed.

READ: Genesis 30: 22-24

Leah could bring forth multiple children, but she could not capture the love she desperately wanted to receive because she was NOT his desire.

Giving birth in the natural will not resolve spiritual issues. Love is a spirit. Recognize all things work together for the good of them that love God and are called according to His purpose. Love God, give love and accept and receive the love that comes back through the people Father releases to bring it.

Thank God for foster parents, adopted children, grandparents, surrogate mothers, mentors, big brothers and big sisters, extended families, our church family and even neighbors that have rescued many from a love-less existence by simply being there and showing unconditional love.

Leah forfeited the joy of motherhood and acceptance of the love from her children while she strived to receive the love from Jacob. You reap what you sow. Sow love and love will come back to YOU

In creation...the conscious man is the male and the subconscious is the female. When the subconscious and the conscious mind are properly synchronized, they portray a picture of perfect marital union. The subconscious will not argue about what is placed into it. Once the conscious is convinced of a truth, the subconscious receives it.

The male (conscious) is the instigator or the initiator. The subconscious (female) carries out the will of the conscious mind (male). God puts a seed in the male mind and a female mind receives it. A woman will multiply and carry out the ideas within the mind of her man.

Whenever God initiates anything, a man may get the thought, but it is up to the woman and God to bring it forth – Matthew 1:21.

When God said “it is not good for man to be alone”, it was not for marital purposes in the natural but for supernatural dominion and reproduction in the earth as it is in heaven.

God reached inside of man and pulled out what was already in Adam to compliment him in the form of a woman. This is a spiritual revelation. We were hid in Christ and at the cross, surgery was performed. Out of the side of Jesus came more than blood and water.

God also pulled out of Christ, his suitable helper, his bride, the church.

Adam was the one to declare: she is bone of my bone and flesh of my flesh. For this cause shall a man leave his father and mother and the two become ONE FLESH.

The last Adam declared the same thing over us!!

Therefore, marriage is a divine experience that reflects a higher spiritual principle and law.

READ: Ephesians 5:22- 32

In lieu of that truth let us revisit what the word teaches about marriage:

READ: Colossians 3:15 – 24 / 1st Peter 3: 1- 17 / 1st Corinthians 7:1-5

1st Corinthians 2:13 – 16

Jesus teaches us to prioritize the value of spiritual relationships.

READ: Mark 10:28 -30 / Luke 8: 19 -21 / Luke 20:27 -36

The woman at the well in John 4 had five (5) husbands yet none could quench her insatiable thirst for life. She was incomplete until she met Jesus.

This represents one married to their five physical senses. Your sight, your hearing, your smell, your feelings and your taste are the five husbands you depend on and look to provide for you. They go to bed with you every night and wake up with you every morning. They walk through life with you and we develop a special intimacy with them til death do us part.

Esau sold his birthright to satisfy one of his senses:

READ: Genesis 25:29-34 & Hebrews 12:16 & 17

Once you despise your birthright by cheapening your spiritual connection and sell it in secret to satisfy your senses or sensuality, the blessing transfers to one that will love, cherish and operate in the covenant of connection.

Judas cheapened his connection with Jesus by selling him in secret for 30 pieces of silver. Afterwards, when convicted, he tried to give it back and they wouldn't take it. Ultimately

he threw the change into the temple, went out and killed himself forfeiting the chance to serve as an apostle of the lamb and early church father. READ: Acts 1:15 – 22

READ: Genesis 27:18 – 36

Jacob valued the birthright and the blessing enough to strive for it.

In spite of the way Jacob received the birthright and the blessing, God confirmed the Abraham covenant over his life, gave him the desire of his heart, met him in desperate places, increased his wealth in Laban's house, allowed him to be the father of many nations through his twelve sons, wrestled with God and received another, higher, blessing, rescued him from his older brother's anger and he remains an icon in Jewish history and lineage.

The only reason he was allowed to keep it was because of God's predestined plan for him to have it.

READ: Romans 9:10 -13

Our divine spiritual connection (marriage with Christ) was pre-determined by the Father before the foundations of the world and He guided us to the place of blessing through peculiar circumstances and situations.

READ: Ephesians 1:2-10

Thank God Jesus is our redeemer and has forgiven us of all trespasses and given us an opportunity to be re-connected to the FATHER. He shadows us with His love in the secret place of his tabernacle where the sacred is secret and the secret is sacred. He places an incorruptible seed in the womb of our desire and promises that if we delight ourselves IN HIM, we will receive the desire of our hearts.

READ: Psalm 91 / PSALM 37:3-5

The only way to get a divorce from your five physical senses is to meet Jesus. He truth will make you FREE!! Not the truth that you know but the truth you allow to be alive in YOU!

Revelations teaches: "The testimony of Jesus is the spirit of prophecy"

You must be prophetically trained and spiritually aligned to transcend to the place where you call forth "deep unto deep" in prayer and meditation while activating the spiritual senses shadowed by the natural:

1. See with spiritual eyes (Ephesians 1:18 & 19)
2. Hear with your spiritual ears (Isaiah 50:4 / Revelation 2:7)
3. Smell the sweet savor of his anointing
4. Feel Christ “in you” (Colossians 1:27) and
5. Taste and see that the Lord is good.

“Let this mind be in you that was also in Christ Jesus.”

A spiritual union nullifies anything birthed in the natural and produces fruit that will remain.

The seed of the fruit will fall to the earth, be broken, covered, enriched by the soil and reproduce in its season more fruit of righteousness.

READ: Genesis 8:22

“The fruit of righteousness is the tree of life and those that love it shall eat the fruit thereof...”

A natural relationship cannot become spiritual unless it is born again.

READ: St. John 3:3 – 8

Every son of God is to reproduce in the world kingdom initiatives through offspring that will be world changers.

The Word and the Spirit is the perfect marital union of thought, constantly working together in the lives of believers.

Why did I get married? When I gave my life to Christ, we became ONE.

READ: 1st Corinthians 1: 16 -20

We are to reproduce ourselves in others by making disciples. As Christ was, so are we now, reconciling men to God, not taking into account their iniquities.

He married us for us to be suitable helpers connecting people to God and one another. There is a Joseph and a Benjamin waiting to be born in the spirit.
